As a charity the Society has been able to reclaim tax on membership subscriptions and donations since 6 April 2000 under the Gift Aid scheme.

For the Society to be able to make this reclaim you must yourself be paying income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax we, and any other charity to which you give money, shall be claiming on your subscription or donation in the relevant tax year. Currently the rate is 28p for each £1; that is £1.40 on a £5 subscription and £2.24 on an £8 joint subscription.

All that is required is for you to complete and return the declaration set out below. Signing the declaration does not commit you to any future payments, and if your circumstances change you can notify us that you wish to cancel your declaration. A declaration once signed remains valid until cancelled, but it doesn't matter if you sign a duplicate.
